M/s OMFED Ltd invites applications from the supplier of milk premix present in the GAIN/UNICEF/WFP/FSSAI list of premix supplier for fortification of staple food items for supply of vitamin A and D2 premix for fortification of milk.

The procedure for enrollment, registration and terms and conditions of supply under the above procurement is detailed below:-

### **1. Scope of Work**

Micronutrient malnutrition in India is a serious public health issue affecting population at large, impacting physical and mental growth. Fortification of staple foods like milk offers a promising opportunity to deliver micronutrient rich foods to larger population and is found to be a solution to combat various deficiency diseases. Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has fast tracked initiatives to raise awareness and encourage the adoption of fortified food amongst both producers and consumers. Standards have been issued, a logo for fortified food has been launched (+F), and a portal has been setup (<http://ffrc.fssai.gov.in/>).

Milk is to be fortified with Vitamin A and Vitamin D. The Odisha State Cooperative Milk Producers Federation Ltd (OMFED) have already taken the lead and started the fortification of milk. Also, encouraged to do so as well, and market them aggressively highlighting the benefits of fortification to consumers.

- 1.1. Procurement of Vitamin A and D2 Premix for the year 2019-20 from the eligible bidders through e-procurement process.
- 1.2. The procedure for enrolment and registration of suppliers, terms and conditions of supply of Vitamin A and D2 Premix is detailed below. Some of the clauses to these terms & conditions may be amended if necessary, prior to the conduct of e-Auction. Details of such amendments will be uploaded in the website [www.omfed.com](http://www.omfed.com) for the information of participants.

## **2. Eligibility / Pre-Qualification Conditions**

- 2.1. Bidder shall be a supplier of vitamin premix present in the GAIN/UNICEF/WFP/FSSAI list of premix suppliers.
- 2.2. Bid should not be submitted for the product/products for which the concern supplier/company stands blacklisted/banner/debarred by any State/Central Govt. or its any agencies procurement on the ground of conviction by court of law or the products being found spurious and adulterated.
- 2.3. The concern supplier/company whose product has been declared as of spurious or adulterated quality and any criminal case is filed and pending in any court shall not be eligible to participate for that particular product, in the Bid. Similarly convicted firm/company shall also not be eligible to participate in the Bid.
- 2.4. The Vitamin A and D2 Premix will be procured from the registered suppliers as per the eligibility criteria.
- 2.5. In order to facilitate eligible bidders for enrolment as registered suppliers to participate in e-procurement process, registration should be listed in the FSSAI premix supplier.
- 2.6. The inspection and evaluation of samples will be carried out in accordance with specified quality parameters as per the procedure stipulated in section-6.
- 2.7. After satisfactory supply of the tendered items by the Successful Bidder within the stipulated time, Payment will be released by OMFED (or Milk Unions) to the suppliers within 30 working days from date of submission of bills as per the procedure stipulated.
- 2.8. The Traders/processors/Suppliers should have valid trade license, import license (If applicable), GST registration issued by concerned authorities. They should be in operation for past two years.
- 2.9. Turnover Rs 10 Lakhs certificate /financial statement certified by a Chartered Account must be submitted.
- 2.10. I.T. returns for F.Y. 2017-18 (Certified copy submitted with Technical bid).
- 2.11. GST for the F.Y.2017-18 (Certified copy submitted with Technical bid).
- 2.12. Photo copy of PAN card (Permanent Account Number) & GST certificate.

### **3. Documents to Be Furnished Along With Application for Registration**

- 3.1. The Vitamin A and D2 Premix Manufacturing Units should have proper valid license by the concerned authority for manufacturing / processing and storing of premix - Copy of which will have to be furnished. The legible and certified copies of the following documents must be attached / annexed to Technical Supporting Documents:
- 3.2. Valid Manufacturing license & Product Permission (as the case may be). For imported products Valid Importing License & Product Permission of manufacturer (as the case may be).
- 3.3. Valid GMP/FSSC/FSSAI certificate of manufacturer for manufacturing Milk Premix.
- 3.4. Valid I.S.I. certificate (if applicable).
- 3.5. Photo copy of PAN card (Permanent Account Number) & GST certificate.
- 3.6. C.A. Certificate in original/ notarized showing year wise production / import & Sales of quoted items for preceding three years.
- 3.7. (ALL PHOTOCOPIES MUST BE SELF CERTIFIED).
- 3.8. The tenderer must satisfy that they are in possession of the requisite permissions / licenses / permits required for the manufacture / supply / sale / distribution of the items as per the specifications for which the offer is made. Failure to enter into contract if selected or to execute the purchase orders after entering into contract for want of permission / license or due to non-supply of certificates / documents will be viewed seriously and will invite forfeiture of risk purchase / disqualification for appropriate period without any further reference.
- 3.9. The claim of price revision of finished goods under any pretext or reason, including the all taxes cost will not be allowed at any stage after the last date of submission of the tenders.
- 3.10. Quantity mentioned in of price quotation is approx. tentative requirement of the item. It may increase or decrease. The rates should not vary with the quantum of requirement.
- 3.11. An affidavit on Rs 100 non judicial stamp paper and Notarized, regarding
  - Not having been prosecuted for violation rules / law under Essential Commodities Act or any such others law or orders there under in any court of law.
  - Not having been black listed by any organization or Government for non-performance of contractual obligation.
- 3.12. The address proof of the authorized signatory viz Telephone bill / copy of pass port / electricity bill / voter ID proof should be submitted along with the application. The address proof in respect of the firm shall be either certificate of registration or certificate of incorporation issued by the concerned authority.
- 3.13. Bank account details of firm along with IFSC code, Branch details, address shall be furnished in the letterhead of the firm.
- 3.14. **Tender cost – Rs 560.00 (including GST) enclosed with Technical document.**
- 3.15. **Required EMD – Rs 50,000.00 enclosed with Technical document.**
- 3.16. The application for registration and terms and condition with relevant Annexure can be downloaded from the website [www.omfed.com](http://www.omfed.com). **Requests for forwarding applications through post / couriers will not be entertained.**

- **Packing Size:** 100g, 200g, 500g
- **Rate of Addition:** 1000g per of premix per 50000 ltrs of Milk
- **Storage:** Store in dark, dry and cool place. Do not expose to sunlight after opening seal, entire content should be used.
- **Shelf Life:** 12 months from date of manufacture
  - **Price:** The price should be quoted for 100 kg of premix for Milk fortification required for a year.
  - **Location:** Bhubaneswar, Balasore, Sambalpur, Dhenkanal, Anugul, Keonjhar, Salapada, Rourkela, Bhawanipatana, Jeypore, Berhampur, Cuttack, & Tangi Dairy
- **Time for Delivery:** Should mention the time in number of days required to deliver the supply in the location starting from date of order
- **Trans\*:** Price for transportation

**Price: The price should be quoted FOR Basis for 1800.kgs (Tentative Annual Requirement attached at Annexure-I) of premix for Milk fortification. Separate purchase orders will be issued for each consignment as per the requirement. There is no binding to buy the above quantity and the quantities of premix brought under this tender shall not exceed given quantities.**

## 6.2 Supply Conditions

- Conforming to FSSAI standards.
- The AT holder must supply the Premix for Milk Fortification and other items of stores as per the standards of quality mentioned & respective pharmacopoeia.



- Purchase orders along with the delivery destinations will be placed on the successful Bidder.
- Delivery Period: The delay in delivery period should be informed to the Undersigned authority.
- In case of Emergency or Epidemics.
  - The order stands cancelled after the expiration of delivery period, and if the extension is not granted with or without liquidated damages.
  - It shall be the responsibility of the supplier for any shortage/ damage/ breakages at the time of receipt at the designated places.

### **6.3 Poly Film Milk pouches**

- Listed as number **1** inside the recycling triangle diagram, commonly used for milk pouches, or Sweetened Flavored Milk bottle/PP Bottle etc bottles. Further, the following details of month and year of packing in the space provided below name and address of the supplier in the following format is also to be printed by the Bidder themselves.
  - i Name and address of the supplier.
  - ii Best before use 12 months.
  - iii FSSAI specification for Milk fortification.
  - iv FSSAI LICENSE Number.
  - v Net Wt.
  - vi Date of Packing.
  - vii Batch No.

### **7. Order for Supply**

- Quantities supplied in excess of the quantity specified in the supply order will not be paid for.
- Supply of required quantity should be as indented by the Federation/Union. Federation/Union at his sole discretion may place Supply orders/indents by FAX/LETTER/E-MAIL.

- The successful qualified supplier is bound to honor such indents and shall arrange to supply requisite quantity of Vitamin A and D2 Premix to the designated dairies.
- The supply of consignment ordered shall be delivered in accordance with the supply order/indent.
- The ordered quantity of Vitamin A and D2 Premix as per specifications prescribed should be delivered within 7 to 10 working days at the 6 unions (or plant location) of OMFED as per the order issued by the Federation.
- As the stock is very urgently required and to ensure uninterrupted supply of Vitamin A and D2 Premix, the OMFED is very keen in getting the stock within the stipulated time and may reduce the delivery time to 7 working days also while issuing supply order. Hence the delivery schedule fixed by the OMFED should be kept up at any cost.

7.1 Violation of any of the Clause/Clauses/Sections of the Agreement shall be deemed as violation of Terms and Conditions of Tender.

7.2 At any stage of supplies under the scheme; if it is noticed that the supplies are not in conformity with the specifications prescribed, such materials are liable to be rejected and qualified supplier will be called upon to make good the same. In the event of qualified supplier failing to make good the rejected stocks, the security Deposit and EMD (margin money) furnished by the qualified supplier shall be forfeited and Corporation is entitled to collect liquidated damages if any from the tender for his failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the tender.

## **8. Terms and Conditions of Delivery**

8.1 All information as per standards of Weights & Measures Act, 1976 & the Standards of Weights & Measures (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 1977 and Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006 and Regulations there under, must be mentioned on each bottle e.g. name and full address of the supplier / Packer, Name of the commodity, gross weight, net weight, month & year of packing of the commodity.

## **9. Terms of Payment**

9.1 After satisfactory supply of the tendered items by the Successful Bidder within the stipulated time, Payment will be released by the OMFED to the suppliers within 30 working days from date of submission of bills with relevant documents to the

OMFED. As per the procedure stipulated the amount will be transferred to respective account of the suppliers by electronic fund transfer.

9.2 The payment is processed based on the accepted quantity at the designated location, quality report by the assayer and is subjected to any standard deductions as specified in the purchase order/indent of Vitamin A and D2 Premix.

9.3 The supplier shall submit the following documents giving delivery of the consignment to the respective unions:

- i Commercial Invoice.
- ii Certificate of Analysis for the batch delivered.
- iii 3<sup>rd</sup> party NABL Testing Report - chemical & microbiological both.
- iv Food grade Certificate for packaging material and ingredient used.

9.4 The payment will be directly released through Electronic Fund Transfer to the account for release to the supplier. The following documents should be submitted at the Federation for processing of payment:

- i Invoices.
- ii Quality certificate issued by third party.
- iii Food grade Certificate.
- iv Any other document.

#### **10. Penalty on Default/Extension Time**

10.1 The entire ordered quantity of Vitamin A and D2 Premix should be supplied within the stipulated time. No extension of time will be granted for supply of Vitamin A and D2 Premix beyond the specified date fixed.

10.2 But in exceptional circumstances and if it is sufficiently proved that the delay in supply is due to the circumstances beyond the control of the suppliers, extension of time will be granted at the discretion of the Purchase Committee subject to the following conditions:

A. A penalty will be imposed per day for the quantity of Vitamin A and D2.

Premix supplied after the due date fixed in the supply order

Supply of stock less than the ordered quantity is not permitted. If the ordered quantity is not supplied in full, the EMD & Security Deposit and amount available with the Corporation will be forfeited besides blacklisting the firm for further not participating in Government tenders for up to 3 to 5 years.

## **11. Cancellation of Agreement**

11.1 The supplier, if breaches any condition or clause of the agreement the Federation is entitled to cancel the agreement and also entitled to demand and recover the loss incurred to it due to such cancellation/termination of the agreement.

11.2 If the Government scheme is closed or partly revised or modified, due to accidental decision of State/Central Government or any amendment and the proceedings of purchase is stopped or revised or modified by the Federation then the agreement will automatically come to an end or partly continues for which supplier is not entitled to demand/receive any type of loss amount or cannot initiate any legal proceedings.

## **12. Confidentiality**

### **12.1 Force Majeure**

- The terms and conditions hereof shall be subject to force majeure. Neither the Corporation nor the supplier shall be considered in default in the performance of their respective obligations herein above if such performance is prevented or delayed because of act of God, War, Flood, Hostilities, Revolution, Civil Commotion, Official Strike, Epidemic, Accident or Fire, or because of Law and Order Proclamation, regulation or ordinance of any Govt. of any Subdivision thereof or local authority.
- The supplier shall be entitled to the benefit of this clause only if he informs in writing of the circumstances amounting to force majeure to the Corporation for each consignment/ dispatch separately within 48 hours of the happening thereof by telegram and fax immediately followed by a confirmatory letter sent by Regd. Post Acknowledgment due.
- In the event of the supplier pleading any ground as constituting force majeure, the opinion of the management of the Corporation on that behalf alone shall prevail and, if in the opinion of the management, the grounds pleaded by the supplier do not amount to force majeure, then supplier shall not be entitled to plead the same and or claim any relief under this clause.

**12.2 Arbitration**

- Resolution of Disputes.

**12.3 Indemnities**

- The Supplier shall defend, indemnify and hold Buyer harmless during and after the tender against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, fines, penalties, actions, procedures and expenses of any nature arising out of, resulting from any violation of any laws by the Supplier or its punishment or any way connected with the acts, negligence, breach, failure to perform obligations relating to the tender.

**12.4 Jurisdiction**

All Civil suits arising by this agreement should be subject to the jurisdiction of the City Civil Court, Bhubaneswar only.
